SOCIAL GATHERINGS <i>*Residents wear face coverings if tolerated, IPAC adherence, cleaning prior/ after</i>	ORGANIZED EVENTS/ SOCIAL GATHERINGS	Physical distancing can be relaxed; limited capacity in a room Cohorting can be relaxed when resident activities are outside Enhanced precautions required Maintain same activity groups as much as possible <i>Singing, dancing, etc. may resume</i>		Individual/ door to door programming only for area(s) in outbreak and isolated residents (caregiver permitted)
DINING	COMMUNAL DINING	Consistent seating of residents at same table – physical distancing can be relaxed. 2m distancing between diners at different tables as much as possible <i>Buffet and family style dining may resume</i> <i>Fully immunized staff and visitors may accompany fully immunized residents for meals</i>		In-suite dining

*Requirements are no longer contingent on immunization coverage rates. Absences are for all residents regardless of immunization status.
